


Work in building & grounds, cleaning, or maintenance

DEFERRED ACTION FOR CHILDHOOD ARRIVALS (DACA)

40,807 recipients since 2012

As of 2019, only **36%** of DACA eligible children had been approved for DACA.



PAID TAXES IN 2018

Immigrant-led families in New York State paid

\$35.4 BILLION

in federal taxes and

\$21.8 BILLION

in state and local taxes.



IMMIGRANTS SUPPORT THE NY ECONOMY
