
NYS Parent Portal Website and Mobile App

The NYS Parent Portal (www.nysparenting.org) is a project of the NYS Council on Children and Families' Preschool Development Birth through Five grant. The website houses four parent-friendly websites created by the NYS Council on Children and Families with state agency partners to help parents and caregivers.

Parents, caregivers and social service professionals can help build a culture of positive parenting-by using these resources to make families aware of childcare options, helpful hints to navigate concerns about development and where to find local parenting support. In addition, covid-19 resources for parents were added in late March 2020 when Governor Cuomo announced that "NYS was on Pause" and families abruptly needed to learn how to parent during a pandemic. *The Council continues to regularly update resources*.

The four websites on the NYS Parent Portal are:

- <u>NYS Childcare</u>, <u>Afterschool and Home Visiting Programs Locator</u>: Provides information on child care, after school and home visiting programs in one easy-to-access location.
- <u>Parent Guide: Starting Life Together:</u> Guide for the first five years of your parenting journey. Whether you are the mother or father (through birth, adoption, or foster care), a grandparent, partner, family friend, aunt or uncle with parenting responsibilities, what you say and do in your role as a parent matters.
- <u>Multiple Systems Navigator</u>: Provides access to helpful health, education, human service and disability information on one user-friendly website. Built for youth, parents, family members and caregivers that rely on supports from multiple child and family serving systems.
- <u>Every Student Present:</u> Learn how to boost your child's confidence, keep your child on track with school work, protect your child from bullies and keep your child healthy.

Ξ #NYLovesTalkingisTeaching When you talk, read, and sing with your child – even before they can understand words – you're helping them learn. #NYLovesTalkingisTeaching Let's talk about hands and feet together. #NYLovesTalkingisTeaching You can play "Peek-a-boo" while getting your baby dressed. Ask, "Where's (baby's name)?" when dressing your baby. NYS Parent Portal Website signatures will be as followed:

- 1. You can copy the signature line straight from this document.
- 2. Go to your outlook online
- 3. Then you will go to the **settings** $\{\widehat{O}\}$ **button** on the top right in between a bell and a question mark
- 4. Once you have clicked on the settings button you will see something that says theme and other options. From this setting menu on the bottom of it you will see **View all Outlook settings** click that!
- More options will appear. It will be by default on the layout menu. In the middle column you will see Compose and reply underneath layout. Click that!
- 6. Now you have made it to your **Email signature**!
- 7. Here you can paste the signature line you copied earlier from the word document and hit save! You will be all set!

NYS Parent Portal App Download signatures will be as followed:

- 1. You can copy the signature line of your liking
- 2. You will need to save both the **app store** and **google play** icons as pictures onto your computer



- 3. Go to your outlook online
- 4. Then you will go to the **settings** $\{O\}$ **button** on the top right in between a bell and a question mark
- 5. Once you have clicked on the settings button you will see something that says theme and other options. From this setting menu on the bottom of it you will see **View all Outlook settings** click that!

- 6. More options will appear. It will be by default on the layout menu. In the middle column you will see **Compose and reply** underneath layout. Click that!
- 7. Now you have made it to your **Email signature!**
- Here you can paste the signature line you copied earlier from the word document
- 9. Now you will go to the **picture icon** all the way to the left of the white box for your email signature
- 10. Here you can insert both your **app store** and **google play** icons you saved earlier to your computer
- 11. You will click on the **apple app store icon** individually to highlight it then you will find the tool in the white box that has **two circles interlocking** that is for inserting links.
- 12.You will insert this link https://apps.apple.com/us/app/nys-parent-portal/id1490917046 now the apple icon is set.
- 13. You will then click on the **google play icon** individually to highlight it then you will find the tool in the white box that has **two circles interlocking** that is for inserting links.
- 14. You will insert this link https://play.google.com/store/apps/details?id=com.parentportal now the google icon is set

Now you have completed your **Email signature!** Hit save and you will be all set!
